

*Meeting of the Brevort Township Board*

*December 8, 2016*

*Minutes*

Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM by Supervisor Serwach.

Board Members present: Supervisor Serwach, Treasurer Litzner, Deputy Clerk Bird, Trustee Wallace, Trustee Erskine,

Also present: St. Ignace News Reporter- Erich Doerer, Fire Chief Mark Peterson, Fireman Ron Peterka, Mark Wilk of Allied EMS, and Daryl Browning- representative of Greymont.

Reading of the Minutes from the November 10, 2014 Brevort Township Board meeting were read. Motion to accept the minutes made by Trustee Erskine, Seconded by Treasurer Litzner.

Treasurer's Report was read by Treasurer Litzner with a total of \$402,033.52 in the general fund and a total of \$118,131.10 in the Sewer Fund. Motion made to accept report by Trustee Erskine and seconded by Supervisor Serwach. Treasurer Litzner provided more information regarding moving funding into a 1 year CD at First National Bank of St. Ignace. Motion was made by Trustee Wallace and Seconded by Trustee Erskine.

Bills against the township were read. A motion to pay the bills was made by Treasurer Litzner and seconded by Trustee Erskine.

Supervisor Serwach read a letter from the Mackinac Co. Road Commission regarding removing Martin Rd from the Seasonal Road list. Also read by Serwach from the Road Commission was the announcement of a meeting on Dec. 16<sup>th</sup> at 3:30 to review transportation projects.

Mark Wilk from Allied EMS provided an update to the board. They are still working out operating budgets. They do have expectations set but they need Allied Board approval.

Daryl Browning of Greymont Quarry in Rexton asked the board to consider signing a revised resolutions. All members read the revision and resigned. Deputy Clerk Bird will send a hard copy to Greymont.

Fire chief Peterson updated the board regarding the recent purchase of a fire truck. The truck came with some extras but needs a few pieces of equipment. They have replaced the stickers/signs on the sides. It will be used as the primary once the fireman are familiar with it.

Fire chief Peterson also requested use of the Fire department credit card. Supervisor Serwach will call bank to check on its status.

Supervisor Serwach received citizen complaints regarding election signs being taken down in a timely manner. The board agreed that an ordinance should be in place.

Meeting adjourned at 6:49 PM. Motion to adjourn was made by Treasurer Litzner and

seconded by Trustee Erskine.
