

**BREVORT TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
MINUTES
July 12, 2021**

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Serwach at 6:00 with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Board members present were Supervisor Serwach, Treasurer Olsen and Clerk Matelski, Trustees William and Tabitha Orr. The public attending were Ron Peterka, Fire Chief Peterson, and Daryll Orr. Clerk Matelski read the June minutes. Motion to approve the minutes made by Trustee William Orr, second by Tabitha Orr. Motion passed.

Clerk Matelski read the bills. A motion to pay the bills was made by Trustee William Orr, second by Clerk Matelski. Motion passed.

Treasurer Olsen read the treasurer's report. Motion to approve report made by Trustee William Orr, second by Clerk Matelski. Motion passed.

Supervisor Serwach announced all the work that needed to be done t the cemetery was completed, and a nice job was done.

Fire Chief Peterson said they are still waiting on the slide in grass fire equipment to be finished. He also brought up installing the radio in the new grass fighting truck. He had contacted Mark Wilk, but hasn't gotten an answer. Bryce Tracey volunteered to do the installation. He will let the board know what has been decided. He also mentioned installing a light on the truck. He said it probably won't be cheap.

Chief Peterson was contacted by a resident asking if the department would do a controlled burn on a structure. The Chief turned them down, as there are insurance and asbestos issues.

There was a change of command at the St. Ignace fire department which Chief Peterson attended.

Treasurer Olsen discussed the internet in Brevort Township. AEG was awarded a 190 million contract to do internet in the EUP and the thumb area. Highlinefast.com will be providing the internet. Supervisor Serwach brought up that there are misunderstanding about Commissioner Lehrke applying for grant money for the park at the end of Dukes road. Supervisor Serwach cautioned the board member about getting calls claiming that we are trying to close the area from township residents, which is untrue.

Supervisor Serwach also brought to the boards attention that there are services for Vern Erskine at the Lutheran Church on July 24th, and for Donna Goudreau on July 31 at the Epoufette Cemetery.
