BOARD MEETING
May 13,2024

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Serwach at 6:00 pm by the Pledge of Allegiance.

All Board members were present, except Trustee T Orr, who was excused.

Clerk Matelski read the April 8 2024 meeting minutes.. Motion to approve minutes made by Trustee W .Orr, seconded by Treasurer Brian Olsen, Motion approved.

Clerk Matelski read the bills due. Motion to approve bills as read made vy Trustee W. Orr, seconded by Treasurer Olsen. Motion approved.

Treasurer B. Olsen read the Treasurer's report for April 2024. Motion to approve the reports made by Trustee W. Orr, seconded by Clerk Matelski. Motion granted.

New Business:

Supervisor Serwach talked about hiring a new Assessor. He placed an ad for employment in the newspaper and three people have applied. He and Trustee W Orr will do interviews and present their recommendation at the June 2024 meeting. Sherry Burd, the current Assessor has agreed to stay on until July 1, 2024.

Supervisor Serwach received a call during the meeting regarding the flags at the community center and fire department being in poor shape. Motion to purchase two new flags made by Treasurer Olsen, seconded by Trustee W. Orr. Motion passed.

Treasurer Olsen has received two proposals from the Mackinac County Road Commission regarding Dukes Road ditch cleaning and adding sand and gravel to Davis Road. He stated that ARPA funds must be appropriated by December 3,2024. Motion to approve both agreements made by Treasurer Olsen and seconded by Clerk Matelski. Both documents were signed by all the board members present.

Treasurer Olsen stated that he has yet to receive estimates regarding the two generators. He is in contact with the State of Michigan regarding a deposit of \$10,000.00.

Chief Peterson stated that one of the main fire hoses is defective and he wished to purchase two more. He cannot get them from Scott CSI in Graying Mi and is looking for another supplier for these items. He stated that the fire department responded to a grass fire, but could not get the truck into the area. He will be looking into getting a price on a side by side utility vehicle.

Chief Peterson stated that he wishes to resign from the Zoning Board of Appeals due to age. He also said Ron Peterka also wishes to resign due to health issues. Chief Peterson has paperwork that he will turn over to the next appointed board member,
