BREVORT TOWNSHIP
Ordinance No. 3

An Ordinance Regulating The Speed of Motor Vehicles in Brevort Township.

The Township of Brevort Ordains:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor vehicle to operate such vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of 25 statute miles per hour on M-123 from Miller Street to William Street in Brevort Township, Mackinac County, Michigan.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor vehicle to operate such vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of 20 statute

miles per hour on Jefferson Avenue or August Street from Miller Street to Moran Avenue.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor vehicle to operate such vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of 25 statute miles per hour on the Brevort Lake Road from John Christensen's Resort to The Massey House.

SECTION 4. Any person convicted of violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 90 days or by both fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the first publication thereof.

Ordinance No. 3

An Ordinance Regulating The Speed of Motor Vehicles in Brevort Township.

The Township of Brevort Ordains:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor vehicle to operate such vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of 25 statute miles per hour on M-123 from ^{Clark Rd.} Miller Street to ^{R. Mill} William Street in Brevort Township, Mackinac County, Michigan.


SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor vehicle to operate such vehicle at a rate speed in excess of 20 statute miles per hour on Jefferson Avenue or August Street from Miller Street to Moran Avenue.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motor vehicle to operate such vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of 25 statute miles per hour on the Brevort Lake Road from John Christensen's Resort to The Massey House.

SECTION 4. Any person convicted of violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 90 days or by both fine and imprisonment.

ORDER TO PLACE SIGNS
TO ESTABLISH MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS

ORDER NO. SP 49-36-63

Pursuant to Section 628(a), Act 300, P.A. 1949, as amended, we have jointly caused an engineering and traffic investigation to be made on State Trunkline Highway M-123

_____ in the
Township of Brevort (Community of Moran) in
Mackinac

County, and having thereby determined that the speed of vehicular traffic is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist at the intersection or other place or upon any part of such highway hereafter described, hereby determine and declare the following reasonable and safe maximum speed limits and direct the Michigan State Highway Department to erect and maintain appropriate signs in conformity with the Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices which give notice of the following determination: **Speed limit of**

fifty (50) miles per hour on State Trunkline Highway M-123 between County

Road Number 425 and Adolphus Street;

forty (40) miles per hour between Adolphus Street and Charlotte Street; and

fifty (50) miles per hour between Charlotte Street and County Road Number 424.

(It is a misdemeanor for any person to fail to observe signs authorized by this Order and this Order becomes effective when signs giving notice of the same have been erected.)

It is directed that a true copy of this Order be filed in the Office of the County Clerk of Mackinac County and copies thereof in the Offices of the State Highway Commissioner and Commissioner of State Police.
