## REGULATING THE PLACEMENT OF HEADSTONES AND ARTIFICAL FLOWERS IN THE CEMETERY GROUNDS LOCATED IN BREVORT TOWNSHIP

### NOTICE 4-12-86 BREVORT TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 14

An Ordinance regulating the placement of headstones and artificial flowers in the cemetery grounds located in Brevort Township:

#### THE TOWNSHIP OF BREVORT ORDAINS:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to place artificial flowers or wreaths on graves in the Brevort Township Cemetery or other cemetery grounds, if those flowers and wreaths contain any metal hangers or a wire support system.

Section 2: Headstones placed in the cemetery must have a

base that is four inches wider than the headstone.

Section 3: Any person convicted of violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 90 days or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the

first publication thereof.

#### BREVORT TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 14 NOTICE

# THE TOWNSHIP OF BREVORT ORDAINS:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to place artificial flowers or wreaths on graves in the Brevort Township Cemetery or other cemetery grounds, if those flowers and wreaths contain any metal hangers or a wire support system.

Section 2. Headstones placed in the cemetery must have a base that is tour inches wider than the headstone.
